What is iDrive?

iDrive is a youth-led, youth-inspired outreach and empowerment program of i-SAFE. iDrive's mission is to empower students, as Agents of change, in their communities—both online and offline — by giving them a voice to speak out about the issue(s) and problem(s) they face. iDrive's vision is to build a strong coalition of teens who work together to address the challenges associated with living in a technology-infused world and shape 21st century leaders.

iDrive gives students the resources and community support they need to carry out your campaign ideas and initiatives, turn challenges into opportunities for innovation, bring awareness to important issues, and create solutions to real-world problems.

We recognize that many young people are fueled with ideas but may lack the resources to effectively plan, design, develop and implement their initiatives. The iDrive Student Toolkit jump-starts your effort to leave your mark on the world. This toolkit includes tips, topics, and tutorials to engage you in a variety of activities such as PSAs, school assemblies, awareness campaigns, short form documentaries, and more.

Become an iDrive Agent

An i-SAFE Agent is a student between the age of 13–18 who wants to bring awareness to real world issues by taking part in iDrive campaigns. Agents can contribute skills and talents to iDrive efforts as writers, photographers, video producers, artists, musicians, app developers, or by simply sharing a post or picture on social media.

Join the iDrive Student Advisory Board

Every school year, i-SAFE accepts resumes from students who wish to represent their peers on the i-SAFE Student Advisory Board. Student Advisors work with i-SAFE executives and iDrive coordinators to brainstorm, create, and develop social campaigns and strategies for raising awareness of specific issues—all to make a positive impact in the world—both online and offline. As leaders in their region, Advisory Board Members combine efforts with Agents to make a positive impact. The Student Advisory Board consists of eleven members and one Chairperson. Students serving on the Advisory Board hold their positions for the duration of one year. Board meetings are monthly. Board Membership is a great way to build a resume and obtain life experiences which will, in turn, give you an advantage when applying for college and entering the workforce.
