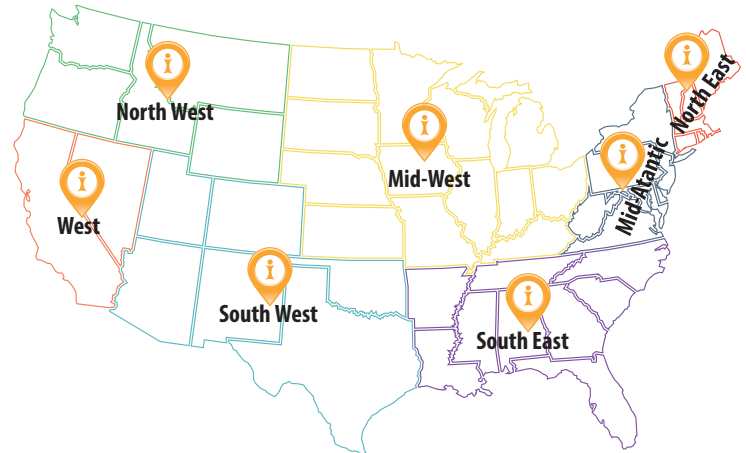


Make a Positive Impact on the World



Become a Student Advisory Board Member

Every school year, i-SAFE accepts resumes from students who wish to represent their peers on the i-SAFE Student Advisory Board. Student Advisors work with i-SAFE executives and iDrive coordinators to brainstorm, create, and develop social campaigns, contests, and strategies for raising awareness of specific issues, all to make a positive impact in the world— both online and offline. As leaders in their region, Advisory Board Members combine efforts with Agents to make big things happen. The Student Advisory Board consists of eleven members and one Chairperson. Students serving on the Advisory Board hold their positions for the duration of one year. Board meetings are monthly. Board Membership is a great way to build a resume and obtain life experiences which will, in turn, benefit you when applying for college and entering the workforce.



Student Advisory Board Qualifications

To qualify as a Student Advisory Board Member, you must be between ages 13-18. In addition to meeting the age requirement, Student Advisory Board members should possess the following qualifications:

- A strong drive to make a positive impact in the world
- Leadership skills and accountability
- Effective verbal and written communications skills
- A desire to work with a diverse team
- Excellent time-management skills
- Creative thinking and problem-solving skills
- The capacity to connect with a wide audience of young people
